## Executive Summary

Approximately 5 million children are born of whom almost 40,000 have congenital heart disease alone in Pakistan. Among them more than 25,000 need invasive surgery in the first year of life while only 2,000 surgeries are being done in the whole of the country. As the numbers suggest there is a very long waiting list and many children die due to waiting for access to appropriate care. There is a huge need for an institution where trained and qualified professional doctors can perform such surgeries and provide care to these helpless children.

Pakistan Children's Heart Foundation (PCHF) has two main objectives; i) to establish a not-for-profit Children's Heart Hospital and Research Institute (CHHRI) in Lahore and ii) to raise awareness for Project Mohsin: funding free heart surgeries through public donations and Zakat.

The CHHRI project envisions the establishment of a 96 bed international standard hospital dedicated to the treatment of children with heart diseases and will utilize the services of some of the leading specialists in the fields of pediatric cardiology and pediatric cardiac surgery, including the promoters of the proposed project. We have gathered together a diverse group of like-minded individuals to act as directors and advisors for this project. The board of directors and advisors comprise of a team of professionals who have excelled in their various fields of expertise. Together, we formed the company "Pakistan Children's Heart Foundation" which is registered with the Securities Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) as a Section 42 Company Ordinance 1984 and is responsible for building the CHHRI. We have been awarded license to operate as NGO in 2012.

The approximate cost of the CHHRI is expected to be PKR 1,099.3 million and required land is 5 Acres according to preliminary feasibility study conducted by Ernst & Young. We have multiple donors and pledges committed to the project and are now in the phase of land acquisition. We are hoping that by joining hands with you, we will take this initiative to the next level. We hope that you will assist us in any way possible way.

Moreover, since the launch of the institution, we have been funding heart surgeries required for the needy patients under the title of Project Mohsin. We use Zakat, certified by Jamia Sharfia and donations to help perform heart surgeries from private as well as public institutions by contributing operation/intervention charges on behalf of patients. Each surgery costs approx. PKR 450,000 and may increase on case to case basis. We have provided financial assistance to 457+ child heart surgeries/interventions so far and the number is growing day by day. It is vital to point out that the public funding (Zakat and other donations) is only utilized for funding patients' surgeries and do not incorporate our administrative cost such as office rent, marketing cost or salaries.

## 1.0 Who We Are

Pakistan Children's Heart Foundation (PCHF) is a not-for-profit company, registered with the Securities Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) as a Section 42 Company, that aims to build awareness in general public and provide financial support to the underprivileged families. There are two main objectives of PCHF: to build a not-for-profit Children Heart Hospital & Research Institute (CHHRI) where state of the art medical treatment will be provided, along with the highest quality of care for children with heart disease, irrespective of their financial means; and secondly, to fund free heart surgeries of children from hard-up families under the umbrella name of Project Mohsin.

### 1.1 Mission Statement

The goal of PCHF is a noble one as stated in the mission statement:

"To establish a state of the art medical facility that provides the highest quality of care for children with heart disease, irrespective of their financial means. To act as a model institute, for the education and training of healthcare professionals, and promote research into the causes and management of congenital heart disease."

## 2.0 PCHF Projects

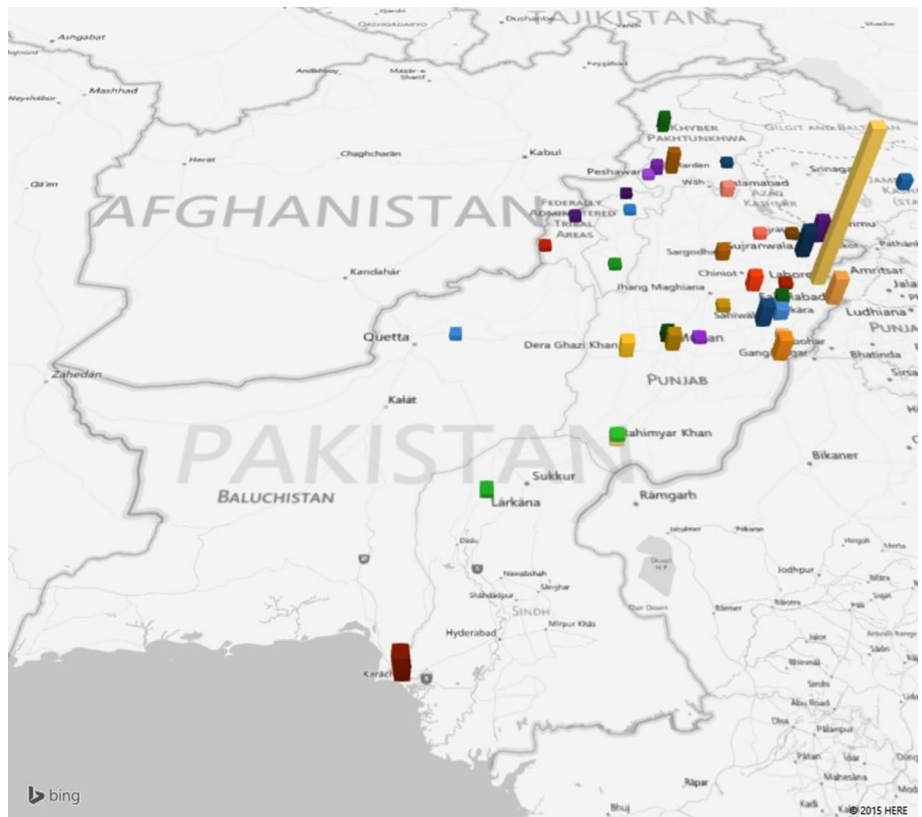
### 2.1 Project Mohsin

#### *Funding Heart Surgeries*

PCHF has funded 457+ surgeries of children across Pakistan (as indicated by the map below) under the umbrella name 'Project Mohsin'. Our focus is to help the economically underprivileged families who cannot bear the expensive treatment as each heart surgery costs an approximate of PKR 450,000; this cost may vary from case to case. In addition, a patient may require more than one surgery for the heart to function normally. It is hence, that PCHF has set up a rigorous process of cross verifications to ensure that funding reaches the eligible families who are unable to stand the heavy surgery expenses.

Once the entitled family is recognized, PCHF launches an immediate action to perform heart surgeries by contributing operation/intervention charges on behalf of the patient. The surgeries are performed at various private and public hospitals by a team of professionals headed by Prof Masood Sadiq. PCHF uses Zakat money and other donations to financially assist these surgeries and not a penny is used from these public donations to cover the administrative cost of PCHF such as office rent, salaries or marketing expenses. Our Zakat funding is certified by Jamia Asharfia.

By God's Grace, ever since the launch of PCHF, we have been receiving generous donations locally and abroad. However, the more people are learning about PCHF, the more is the need for public funding growing by two-fold. It is thus, that we call for support from people like you.



## 2.2 CHHRI Project

The Children's Heart Hospital & Research Institute is a brainchild of PCHF where we aim to build a modern and technically advanced children's hospital in Lahore that would provide treatment to children with congenital heart disease across Pakistan free of cost.

### 2.2.1 Feasibility Summary

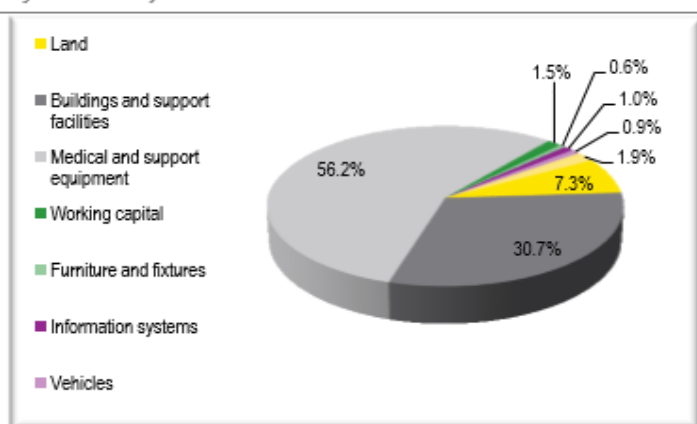

The facility is proposed to be set up at a piece of land located preferably near to ring road in Lahore measuring about 5 acres. The cost of land has been estimated at PKR 16.0 million/acre.
